TWO NEW ORDERS IN THE FACILITY MANAGEMENT SECTOR

- *Two large public-sector contracts through **MST**:*
 - 1) *management and maintenance of the **INPDAP Central and Provincial Headquarters in Rome***
 - 2) *management and maintenance of **367 post office branches run by Poste Italiane***
- *Total value of contracting: € 15.9 million*

Rome, 7 May 2008 – Through its wholly owned subsidiary **MST S.p.A.**, **Maire Tecnimont S.p.A.** was awarded two new facility management and maintenance contracts.

The first, for the management and maintenance of the **INPDAP Central and Provincial Headquarters** in Rome, awarded following a call for tenders for which bids were offered by all the major domestic players. The six-year contract, for **€12.5 million**, entails the employment of 25 staff members working on site covering 24h.

The second contract, also for a term of six years, is for the management and maintenance of **367 post office branches**, including 7 in the Lazio region, awarded by Poste Italiane for a total of **€3.4 million**.

These orders confirm MST's excellent ranking as a leading player in public-sector facility management.

Maire Tecnimont S.p.A. is the parent company of an international industrial group which provides a comprehensive, integrated system of services and installations in its sectors: Chemicals and Petrochemicals, Oil & Gas, Power, Civil Engineering and Infrastructure.
